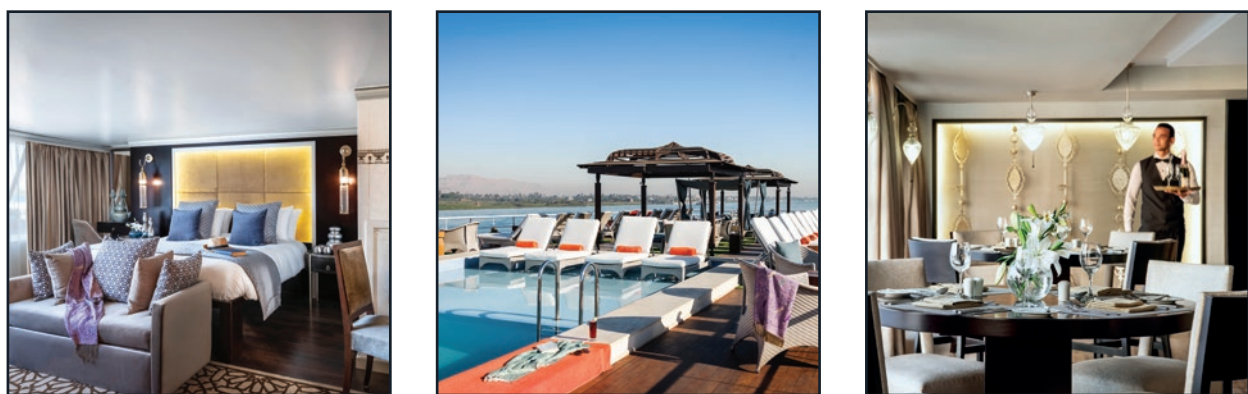

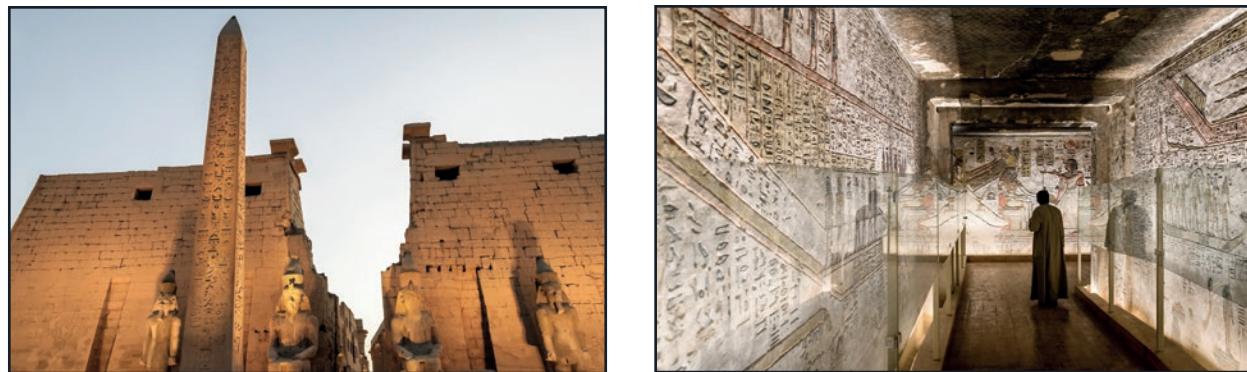


HIGHLIGHTS



KARNAK TEMPLE

Karnak Temple was built over a period of more than two thousand years by generations of Pharaohs and is still one of the largest religious buildings in the world. The great 'Hypostyle Hall' is an incredible forest of giant pillars.



LUXOR TEMPLE

Dedicated to the God Amun, this was the site of the 'Festival of Opet' beautifully depicted on the western wall of the court.

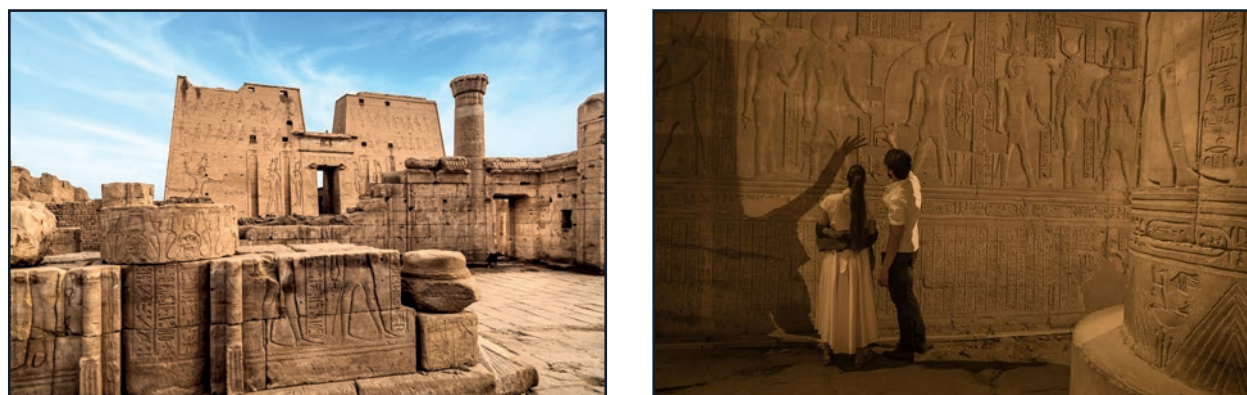
VALLEY OF THE KINGS

The Valley of the Kings, a vast "City of the Dead" where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, is decorated richly and filled with treasures for the afterlife laid by generations of Pharaohs.



TEMPLE OF QUEEN HATSHEPSUT

Considered to be one of the most spectacular wonders of Ancient Egypt, this beautiful temple is dedicated to Queen Hatshepsut and Amun.



TEMPLE OF HORUS

The largest and most completely preserved Pharaonic – albeit Greek built – temple in Egypt dedicated to the falcon god Horus.

KOM OMBO TEMPLE

Dedicated to the crocodile-god Sobek, the Temple of Kom Ombo stands at a bend in the Nile where in ancient times sacred crocodiles basked in the sun on the riverbank.



FELUCCA SAILING

Ride on a felucca, a typical Egyptian sail boat, around Elephantine Island, Lord Kitchener's Botanical Gardens and the Agha Khan Mausoleum.



PHILAE TEMPLE

Philae Temple on the Island of Agilika is regarded as one of the most romantic temples in Egypt. The temple is dedicated to Isis, the ancient Egyptian goddess of purity, sexuality, nature and protection.



COOKING DEMONSTRATION

Guests will have the option to participate in a cooking demonstration as talented chefs show how to create a delicious Egyptian feast.

WHIRLING DERVISH SHOW

Guests will be mesmerised as they watch the whirling dervish show. This dance is a fantastic show highlighting an Egyptian tradition.

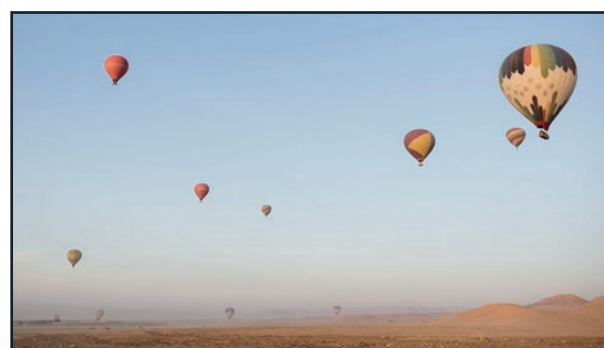
NUBIAN VILLAGE

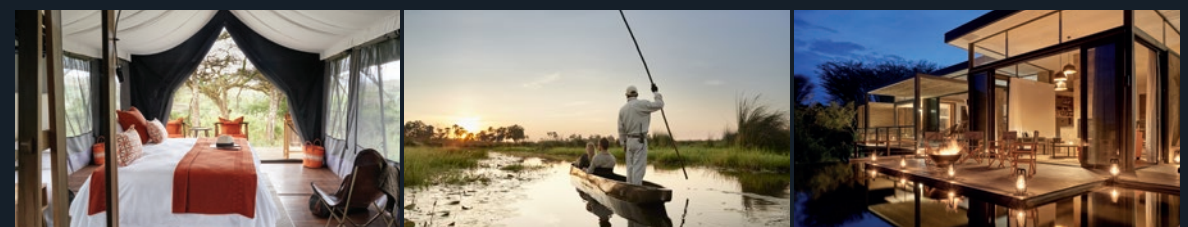

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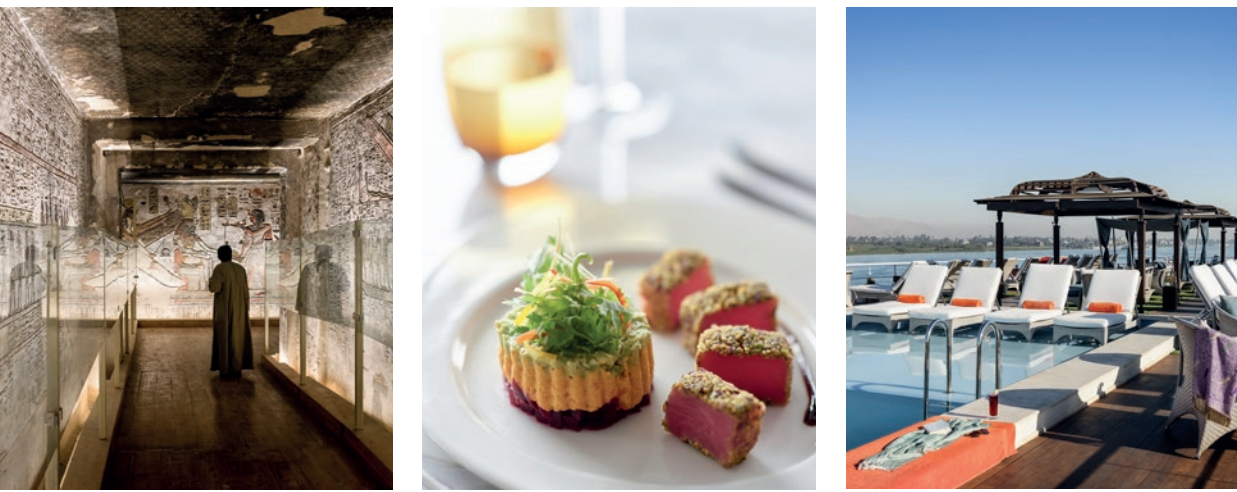
ITINERARIES

LUXOR - ASWAN

4-NIGHT NILE CRUISE



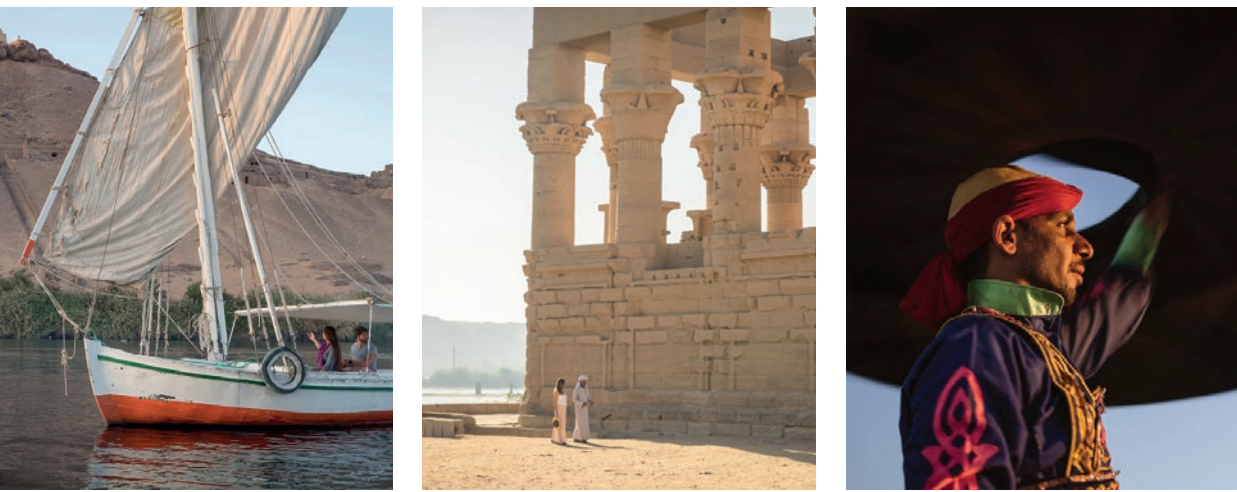
DAY 1 Check in to your Nile cruise boat and enjoy lunch on board. After lunch, visit the East Bank and explore Luxor Temple and Karnak Temple. Evening activities include a drinks reception followed by a gourmet dinner.



DAY 2 After a delicious breakfast on board, the tour of the West Bank will begin with a visit to Valley of the Kings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. On the way back, pass by the famed Colossi of Memnon. Afternoon tea will be served on board followed by a delicious dinner.



DAY 3 Following the sailing to Edfu, visit the Temple of Horus. Lunch will be served on board while cruising to Kom Ombo. Take part in an Egyptian cooking lesson and afterwards, visit the Temple of Kom Ombo. Return to your boat for the sailing to Aswan with the night's entertainment including Egyptian Night where guests can dress in traditional 'galabeyyas'.



DAY 4 A breakfast buffet will be served on board, after which you will have the morning at your leisure. Enjoy lunch before taking a motorboat ride to the Philae Temple. Next, visit the Granite Quarries and Unfinished Obelisk. In the afternoon, ride on a felucca around Elephantine Island, Lord Kitchener's Botanical Gardens and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Evening activities include a Dervish show and belly dancer performance.

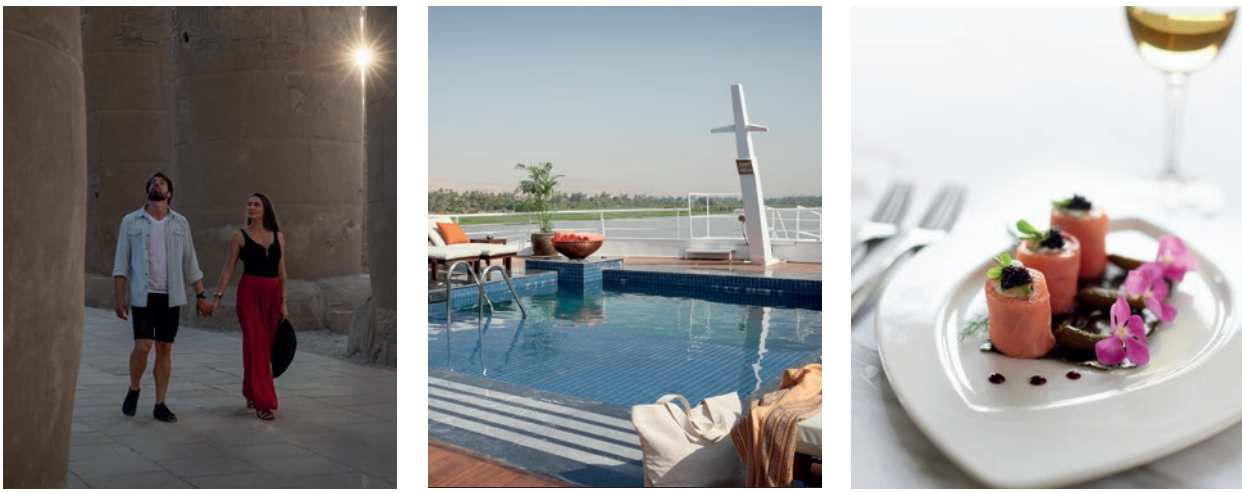
4-NIGHT NILE CRUISE



DAY 1 Check in to your deluxe Nile cruise boat then enjoy lunch on board. In the afternoon, take a ride on a felucca around Elephantine Island, Lord Kitchener's Botanical Gardens, and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. A gourmet dinner will be served on board.



DAY 2 Take a motorboat to Philae Temple on the Island of Agilika, before visiting the Granite Quarries and the Unfinished Obelisk. Lunch will be served on board while sailing then explore the Temple of Kom Ombo. Enjoy a dinner on board followed by a movie night.



DAY 3 Breakfast is served on board while sailing to Edfu. Visit the Temple of Horus at Edfu following which the boat will sail to Luxor. Take part in an Egyptian cooking lesson after lunch. In the afternoon, your Egyptologist will guide you round the Temple of Luxor. Tonight's entertainment will be an Egyptian night where guests can dress up in traditional galabeyya.



DAY 4 In the morning, your Egyptologist will guide you around the Valley of the Kings. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and on the way back, pass by the famed Colossi of Memnon. After lunch, visit the Temple of Karnak. Evening entertainment includes a gala dinner followed by a Dervish show and belly dancer performance.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

- All visitors to Egypt are required to carry a passport valid for six months beyond the intended length of stay. All visitors should check the visa requirements before travel. Some nationalities may need a pre-arrival visa while others can obtain one at the airport on arrival.
- We recommend flying from Cairo to Luxor or Aswan directly.



FLYING TIMES:

- Cairo to Luxor - 1 hour
- Cairo to Aswan - 1 hour and 30 minutes



TRANSFER TIMES:

- Luxor Airport to dock - 30 minutes
- Aswan Airport to dock - 45 minutes
