## Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp, Bwindi Impenetrable Forest





## Remote and Atmospheric Camp

As the only concessionaire luxury camp within Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp is the perfect base from which to track the park's most famous resident – the mountain gorilla. Due to its unique location, it's not unusual for the gorilla families to visit the camp itself. The camp has a bar and dining cottage overlooking the rainforest, as well as a raised natural platform for open-air dining.





## Relax in the Rainforest

The eight tents at Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp are stylish and spacious – exactly what is needed after a day spent tracking gorillas. In addition to the comfortable warm beds, each tent has a huge bathtub that looks straight into the jungle canopy. Observe rare forest species while soaking in the tub, followed by a cocktail on the private viewing deck served by a personal attendant.



## Gorilla Tracking

Bwindi is home to half the world's remaining mountain gorillas. Visitors come here for the once in a lifetime opportunity to come face to face with one of the nine family groups. Although the gorillas are completely wild, they are used to seeing a few humans after a delicate habituation process and each day a handful of visitors are permitted to track each family.





## Meet the Batwa Pygmies

Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp offers more than just gorilla trekking. Gain a fascinating insight into a unique local culture with a visit to the threatened Batwa Pygmy community, located on the periphery of the Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. As part of our philanthropic work, we contribute towards the hospital, school and homesteads and a visit to the tribe is a memorable way to spend an afternoon.

## Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp, Bwindi Impenetrable Forest

### Location:

- Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp is an atmospheric camp located inside Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, a UNESCO World Heritage site in southwest Uganda
- Access is possible both by air and road. Please contact us for more information

### Guest rooms:

- Eight large en suite tents, all with two queen-sized beds, private deck and a bathtub looking out onto the forest - ideal for soaking away aches after a day searching for gorillas
- Each tent has a personal attendant to attend to guests' every need

### Dining:

- Breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner included in your stay
- All meals are a la carte and will be served in the bar and dining cottage overlooking the rainforest, or on an open air natural raised platform
- A silver service dinner is provided with four to five courses each evening
- Romantic private dinners can be arranged upon request

### Activities:

- The main activity at Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp is gorilla tracking
- Permits need to be bought in advance, please contact us for more information
- Thanks to our unique sedan chair, guests who are unable to trek on foot can be carried into the rainforest by our porters
- Birding walks and forest walks are available. Bwindi is home to over 350 species of birds and 200 types of butterflies, as well as rare forest elephant, giant forest hog and eleven kinds of primates, including red tailed and blue monkey, black and white colobus, baboons and chimpanzee
