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# Sanctuary Zambezi Kulefu



## Secluded Tented Camp, Zambia, 7 rooms

**The Zambezi shares a heady mix of strength and tranquility with all who come close to it — and it is this very special essence which Sanctuary Zambezi Kulefu Camp manages to capture. Kulefu, which means “the faraway place”, is an Eden of wild places, located on a permanent channel of the Zambezi in the cool shade of a grove of Winterthorn Acacias. Seven spacious canvas tents surround a magnificent Bedouin-style central area, lit at night by the glow of a campfire and traditional paraffin lamps for a truly authentic bush experience.**

### LOCATION

Deep in the game-rich Lower Zambezi National Park, this is a secluded and intimate safari camp settled comfortably in the deep shade of tall riverine trees.

### GETTING THERE

Access to Zambezi Kulefu Camp is by light aircraft to Kulefu Airstrip followed by a 20 minute boat transfer. The transfer may take longer depending on game viewing opportunities en route. Please note the luggage restriction is 15kg per person in a soft-sided bag. **(NB:** Should the rains start early in October, flights may have to land at the Jeki Airstrip or Royal Zambezi Airstrip).

### ACCOMMODATION & FACILITIES

The camp offers seven spacious tents with twin or double beds, mosquito nets, en-suite facilities

and tranquil views of the Zambezi River. The central lounge and dining area are housed in two magnificent Bedouin style tents, giving an open-air feel and harmonising with the surrounding environment. There is a refreshing swimming pool and teak deck overlooking the river.

### ACTIVITIES

The area offers impressive game viewing with regular sightings of lion, leopard and serval. Other animals include elephants, hippo, wild dog, buffalo and general game. Bird watching and stargazing are also popular activities.

#### Game Drives

Guests can take professionally guided day and night drives through the riverine woodlands in customised 4 x 4 vehicles

#### Walking Safaris

Game walks offer a perfect way to experience the bush up close and personal. Walking safaris are conducted by a professional guide



and are always escorted by an armed national parks scout.

#### Motorised boat

Early morning or sunset river cruises are available as well as fishing in the Zambezi River (subject to water levels).

#### Canoeing Excursions

Enjoy an unforgettable canoe ride down the river to see the local wildlife from the river level.

#### Fishing Excursions

Fishing trips for game fish such as catfish, bream or the renowned tigerfish on a catch and release basis can be organised.

**This seasonal camp operates from mid April until mid November each year.**



#### CLIMATE & CLOTHING

The “dry” season is from May to November and is the easiest time to travel. June to August are the coolest months, with cold mornings and evenings. October is the hottest month in Zambia, so be prepared for temperatures of over 40°C if you travel then.

Clothing should be cool and comfortable. Jerseys and heavier jackets are required for winter mornings and evenings. Muted colours are the most suitable on safari. It is advisable to wear long sleeves and long trousers for mornings and evenings due to mosquitoes. Sturdy and comfortable shoes are essential. A fully complimentary laundry service is offered daily.

#### HEALTH

Malaria is a serious concern in Zambia. Please consult your doctor for the best prophylaxis. Bottled mineral water is supplied by the lodge.

#### CHILDREN

Children 12 years and older are accepted at this camp.

#### CREDIT CARDS

All extras can be paid for with Visa, American Express and

MasterCard credit cards, in addition to travellers cheques and cash (US\$ and Kwacha only). Diners Card is not accepted.

#### ACCESSORIES

Sunscreen, sunglasses and hats are essential. Eye drops are recommended. Binoculars and cameras are an absolute must. The camp provides a torch as well as complimentary mosquito repellent and toiletries.

#### SPECIAL REQUESTS

Sanctuary Zambezi Kulefu Camp prides itself on its personalised services. Please do alert us on booking of any special requests, dietary requirements, allergies or medical conditions.

#### RATES

Rates are inclusive of accommodation, camp transfers to/from Kulefu Airstrip, Jeki Airstrip or Royal Airstrip either by boat or vehicle depending on the season and weather conditions, 3 meals a day, 2 inclusive activities per day, National Park entrance fees, soft drinks, house wines, local beers and spirits, and laundry service.

Rates do not include any visas which are required, or premium brands and spirits.
